The (1876) Carriage Restoration

Having secured the carriage from the worst of the weather by the use of tarpaulins, initial exploratory work is slowly taking place on the interior. The floorboards of the compartment section have received a temporary replacement thus making it a safe place to work. The brake end of the carriage will be similarly dealt with over the next few months.

The framework of the body is now being examined to determine what needs to be repaired or replaced. Surprisingly, some is better than expected, bearing in mind the length of time that the body has been grounded. However there are several sections that are missing, or need to be replaced, and a scheme is being devised in order to insert these without having to dismantle too much of the structure. This work though will probably have to await the spring, when weather conditions make it more conducive to work on the carriage. 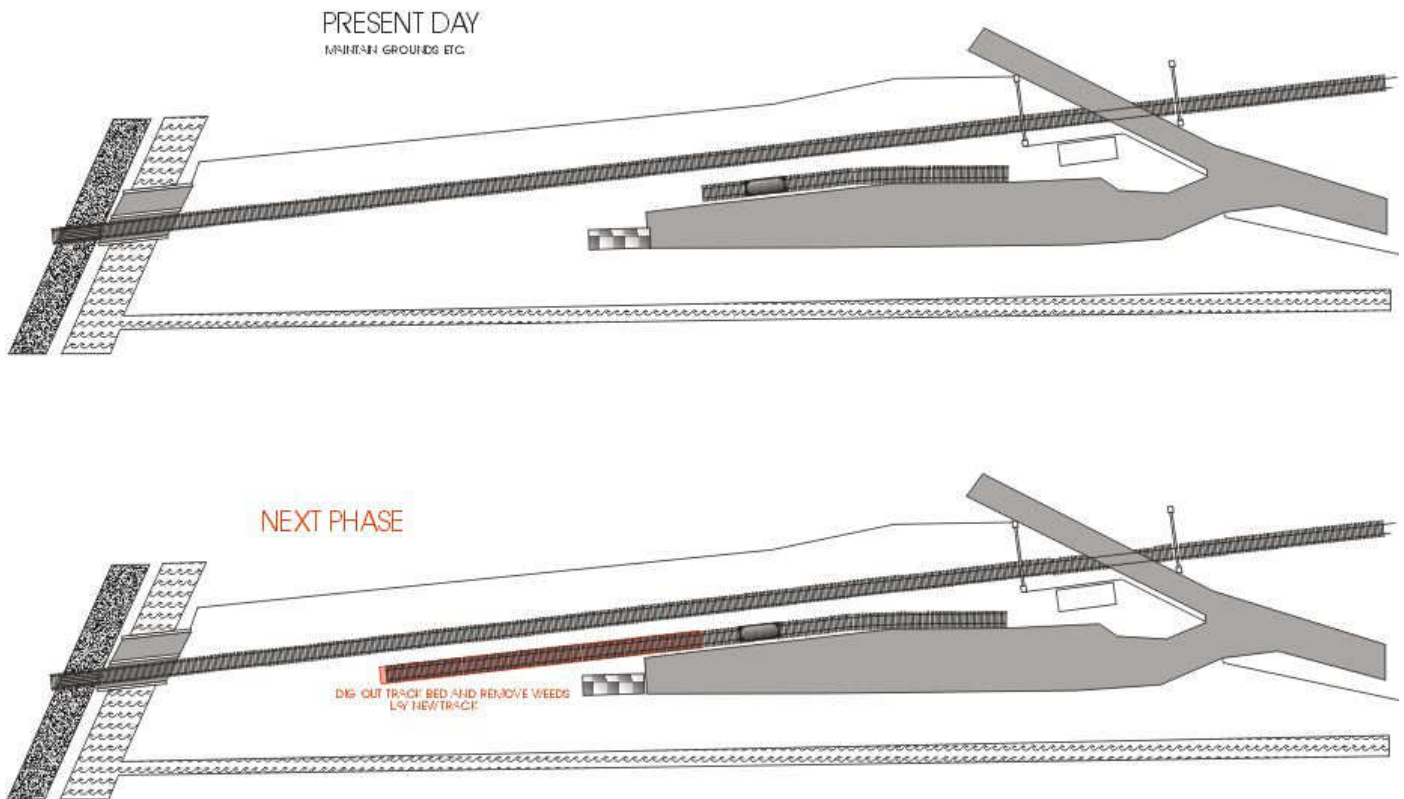
